## Where were you born and raised?

Born and raised in Phoenix. Spent most of my time outdoors blowing stuff up and getting in trouble.

#### What other radio stations?

I started at the college station. Day 1, Sunday at 6 am, I was so nervous I started a record and went out to go to the bathroom. I locked myself out and

had to call the head of the Broadcasting Department at 6:05 am on a Sunday morning.

Then I worked at the local station in Arkansas, playing Rick Dees Weekly Top 40. That¹s where my "love affair" with Rick Dees was born. How could someone so fake be so successful?

## How do you decide who brings in clips from a TV show and how long does that take?

We usually just alternate. It takes about twice as long as the show. So for a half hour show it usually takes about an hour. But that 1s not exactly work.

### How much TV do you watch?

I watch a ton of TV shows. Most are shows I like. Some are shows we need for the radio. I have 4 DVRs and they¹re always busy. One of them is just Barcelona soccer, Galaxy soccer, Lakers basketball, and Cardinals football. The other 3 are for porn.

## What¹s the biggest misconception people have about you or the show?

A lot of people think I<sup>1</sup>m white.

#### Name a few things that you feel have been most successful on the show.

It's the people. Ralph Garman is a genius. Jimmy Kimmel was a genius. Matt Money Smith was a dude. Bean and I are just ring-masters.

Our general manager forced his way into the studio and told us we HAD to stop. And he wanted us to go on the air and apologize. Bean made him do it. Boy was he pissed.
